

Prof. Dr. Nadhir Al-Ansari



Prof. Dr. Nadhir Al-Ansari received his B.Sc. and M.Sc. degrees from the University of Baghdad in 1968 and 1972, respectively. He got his Ph.D. degree from Dundee University in water resources engineering in 1976. Now he is a Professor at the Department of Civil, Environmental, and Natural Resources Engineering at Lulea Technical University Sweden. Previously worked at Baghdad University 1976-1995, and then at Al-Bayt University in Jordan (1995-2007). His research interests are water resources and the environment. Served in academic administrative posts (Dean and Head of Department). Publications include >900 articles in international/national journals, chapters in books, and 22 books. He executed more than 60 major research projects in Iraq, Jordan, Sweden, and the UK. Awarded several scientific and educational awards, among them the British Council on its 70th Anniversary awarded him the top 5 scientists in Cultural Relations. One patent on physical methods for the separation of iron oxides. Supervised more than 70 postgraduate students at universities in Iraq, Jordan, UK, Sweden, and Australia. Member of several scientific societies e.g., International Association of Hydrological Sciences, Chartered Institution of Water and Environment Management, IAHR, etc. Member of the editorial board of 46 international journals and chief editor of 3 journals.
