Dr. Diary Ali is a professor at the University of Sulaimani and is currently working as the dean of the Computer Science Institute at the Sulaimani Polytechnic University. He has 23 years of experience working in the field of water resources, teaching hydrology, hydrogeology, and groundwater modeling courses, as well as researching.
