

Prof. Dr. Basim Al-Qayim



Dr. Basim Al-Qayim had finished his B.sc. and M.sc. degrees in geology from the University of Baghdad. He earned his Ph.D. in stratigraphy and sedimentology from the University of Pittsburgh, US in 1983. Since 1977 he has engaged in his academic career by teaching undergraduate and graduate courses in several universities amongst Sulaimaniyah, Salahuddine, Baghdad, Sana'a, Thamar, and Komar. Since 2004 he has been working as a professor of geology at the Department of Geosciences, University of Sulaimani. He is now retired and working as a private consultant. He has published three books, and more than 100 scientific papers on the geology of Iraq and Yemen with a special focus on the Mesozoic-Cenozoic stratigraphy and reservoir geology of the Zagros Foreland Basin of northern Iraq. He was a visiting scholar (Fulbright) at Florida State University in 2011. He is a member of AAPG, EAGE, SEPM, IAS, and IGU, in addition to the editorial board member of the Iraqi Bulletin of Geology and Mining. His research interests are stratigraphy and carbonate reservoir characterization of the Zagros foreland and petroleum basin.
