He obtained his Ph.D. in the field of Hydrogeology from the University des Sciences et Techniques, Montpellier, France in 1975, his DEA d'Hydrogeologie from the Universite des Sciences et Techniques du Languedoc, Montpellier, France in 1972, and his B.Sc. in Geophysics from the Pennsylvania State University, USA in 1965. He worked in many professional positions, such as the head of the Groundwater Studies Center at the Ministry of Irrigation since 2004; expert at the Ministry of Irrigation between 1994 and 2003; senior hydrogeologist at the Ministry of Irrigation between 1990 and 1993; researcher at the Scientific Research Council between 1976 and 1989; researcher assistance at the Foundation of Scientific Research between 1967&1975. In addition, educational experience includes courses teaching at the University at both the undergraduate and the graduate levels for engineering and earth sciences students during the years 1978-1980, and 1993-1994. Supervising postgraduate students included five theses for the PhD degree and ten for the MSC degrees in 1986 and 2004. He gains wide experience in the field of groundwater resources evaluation, Groundwater pollution and related problems, artificial recharge, groundwater level control, and groundwater modeling. He published more than 25 papers in scientific journals between 1980 and 2004.
